Bratislava is the capital of Slovakia and, with a population of about 420,000, the country's largest city. Administratively and for self-governance purposes, Bratislava is divided into 17 boroughs. Bratislava Karlova Ves Municipality, located in the western part of Bratislava city, is a legal person with the legal responsibilities concerned with administration of the Municipality, its property and it executes all matters with self-governing effect according to particular law. It has important role in land planning and in defining regulatives for housing, buildings, management of public spaces and green infrastructure.

Bratislava Karlova Ves Municipality has started to deal with the topic of the adaptation and mitigation to climate change intensively after 2014 and would like to focus on urban resilience, due to expected negative impacts of climate change, especially in the residential areas with prevalingly prefabricated buildings. The adaptation to climate change is one of the top priorities in terms of the strategical development document called "Social and Economic Development Program of Bratislava Karlova Ves for 2016-2023". Starting in January 2017, Bratislava Karlova Ves Municipality is implementing 5 year project "Planning for Environment and Resource eEfficiency in European Cities and Towns -acronym Perfect" funded through INTERREG Europe focusing on green Infrastructure issues. The overall objective of PERFECT is the identification, analysis, dissemination and transfer of good practices and policy experiences in the multiuse of green Infrastructure. Bratislava Karlova Ves Municipality is focusing on practical biodiversity protection and became officially the first "bees friendly" municipality in Slovakia. Bratislava Karlova Ves Municipality is implementing the project Planning for Environment and Resource eEfficiency in European Cities and Towns – acronym Perfect (project code PGI01983, funding ERDF through INTERREG EUROPE, with overall contract value 2 164 376,- EUR started from January 2017 with the expected end 2022. The Lead Partner is Town and country Planning association (UK) (more info on <https://www.interregeurope.eu/perfect/> The aim of the PERFECT project is to improve the implementation of regional development policies for the protection and development of natural heritage through the recognition of the multiple benefits of green Infrastructure by Managing Authorities, partners and stakeholder groups. The Green infrastructre Action Plan for Bratislava Karlova Ves Municipality as project output will serve as a one of the partial base document in Climate Resilient Low Carbon Action Plan (CReLoCa AP, see C2)

CDI was leading partner of the project " LOC-CLIM-ACT: Local acting on climate change impacts" (project code HUSKROUA/1001/079) funded by ERDF funds in the frame of the Hungary-Slovakia-Romania-Ukraine ENPI CBC Program 2007-2013, with overall contract value € 341 026, started 09/2012 and finished 02/2015. The overall objective of the project was to increase preparedness for local acting on emergencies resulting from the climate change impacts at the local level. The project contributed to the implementation of first climate adaptation activities in Slovakia, Ukraine and Hungary. Three climate change adaptation strategies in three cities or regions in Slovakia, Hungary and Ukraine have been elaborated. Minimum of 170 employees of local public administration authorities learnt about the topic of climate change adaptation in detail. Sixty teachers, active citizens and journalists have been strongly involved in order to spread the information about these challenges. An international Network of Climate Change Adaptation Advisory Centers in Hungary, Ukraine and Slovakia and the website on climate change adaptation for local public administration, journalists and active citizens in four languages – Hungarian, Ukrainian, Slovak and English – were created. Two publications on the topic of climate change and climate change adaptation with the print run of more than 3,000 were published and distributed in each of the partner countries.

CDI was methodological and expert leader of the project "Climcross Development: Partnership for addressing climate change impacts on development" (project code HUSK/1101/1.5.1/0128) funded by ERDF funds in the frame of the Hungary-Slovakia Cross-border Co-operation Program 2007-2013, with overall contract value € 149 842, started 01/2013 and finished 03/2014. The main results of the project were elaborated climate change adaptation strategies in the City Borough Kosice-Zapad and the City of Miskolc.

- For those actions which fall within the eligibility criteria for financing through other European Union funding programmes, **please explain in full detail** why you consider that those actions are better suited to financing through LIFE and are therefore included in the current project:

The issue of adaptation to the climate change fall within the eligibilty to be financed through different funding programs, however the DELIVER actions are suited for LIFE financement from the following reasons:

The DELIVER prpjct is aiming on balancing of adaptation and mitigation issues and such approach is not fostered in other funding schemes. Moreover, the more research oriented adaptation projects could be financed under the Horizon2020 calls, but DELIVER actions do not have such a research character (it is only envisaged to use of the Horizon 2020 project´s outputs, e.g. standardized vulnerability assessment developed by RESIN Horizon 2020 project, see C2).

The topic of adaptation to climate change could be financed through the Slovak Operational Program "Quality of the Environment" as well. However, the main objective of this Operational Programme (OP) is to support sustainable and efficient use of natural resources, ensure environmental protection,

active adaptation to climate change and promotion of an energy efficient, low-carbon economy. The adaptation to climate change is included into the Priority Axis 2 under the "Adaptation to the adverse effects of climate change with the focus on flood protection". However the call oriented the specific objective of the priority axis 2 to reduce the risk of flooding and negative effects of climate change by the means of the green infrastructure is still no open. The mentioned Priority axis 2 neither covering any "mitigation" actions nor supporting the elaboration of strategical documents and other tools for measuring the progress towards the resiliency for municipalities.

The cooperation and transnational exchange in the frame of the learning networks as it is in the URBACT program is not fitting to the purpose of DELIVER project as well.

The program of cross border cooperation between Slovakia and the Czech Republic INTERREG 2014-2020 ([http://www.sk-cz.eu/sk/uvodna-stranka/2014\\_2020/](http://www.sk-cz.eu/sk/uvodna-stranka/2014_2020/)) is not focusing on the topic of climate change and is not covering the all the actions that are envisaged for realization under the DELIVER project.

The programe INTERREG Europe is promoting the cooperation and exchanges but any pilot investment activities.

From the reasons mentionned above , the actions of Deliver project focusing on balancing the adaptation and mitigation issues with regards to biodiversity promotion in residential areas prevailingly consisting of prefabricated buildings with a large number of apartments with cross border and international character are belonging prior to the LIFE priority "Climate change adaptation" for funding.
